Zachary Meisnhiemer unveiled agenda

## Russ went through financials

- \$1000-2000 deficit expected despite fee increase last year of \$100 per team
- \$50 pre team expected for 2010

## Schedule review

- No changes
- Too late to reschedule games going forward till the end of season
- Final dates have been set at Burnaby Lakes. Dates on league calendar.
- Tom will contact higher seeded teams to make sure dates work with high seeds
  - o Jim Bott from Maple Ridge raised concern of 4 teams in 3<sup>rd</sup> division North conference

#### Rosters

• Rosters are frozen as per 3 june 09

## **Trophies**

- Trophies to be returned to Stefan if they were not brought to meeting
- Christ like voting to be done by managers. Forms to be sent to managers by mid June.
- Votes are due one week after final regular season game played

## Cup format

- Zachary Meisnhiemer reviewed format
- Third division different this year due to 11 teams in division
- Cup quarter finals start Friday 26 Jun09
- Tie breakers are not GF/GA
  - o It is head to head tie break and head to head GF/GA

## Discipline

- Overall high amount of infractions this year.
  - Team conduct
  - o Ineligible players

- Yellow card count high this year
- Need to continue to work at communicating with the players to have a Christ like attitude.
- Matt from Cap Church raised question
  - Is the current system enough of a deterrent, point system is now felt to be too high?
    - Is reduction in points possible?
    - Zachary Meisnhiemer penalty points have increased since 2002 from 8 to 15.
      - Number of cards is not an indicator of behavior
      - Cards are tool of referee to control match
      - If points are low referee may have been hesitant to give cards to properly control the game
  - Andy from Willows FC says responsibility lies with manager to enforce rules to talk to players.
    - Zachary Meisnhiemer manager has large role to control the players.
    - Discussion on how to improve control on the field
      - Benefits managers to be on sideline to be able to see whole game
      - Team of leaders, not just a manager, needed to run a strong and successful team
  - Zachary Meisnhiemer raised issue of some of the referees used through this year
    - Discussion with head ref ongoing and working to improve quality of refereeing
- Zachary Meisnhiemer stated again that all cash must be paid to the referee prior to the game
- In the instance of forfeit the team that forfeits must pay the whole referee amount
  - Team guilty of forfeit is fined \$90 to cover ref and field costs
  - If you know you will not have enough players you (or team representative) still need to show up to pay the referee
  - All effort must be made to gather players to put a game on as you are affecting the other team
- Zachary Meisnhiemer restated game sheets to be done correctly and accurately.
  Winning manager has the responsibility to make sure the game sheet is filled correctly.

#### Questions or Sharing

- Vicky from Youth Church shared a player on their team has started to have better attitude to church and is bringing friend to church
- Stefan has invited opponent teams after game to fellowship
- Andrei from Johnson heights, question re game sheets.

- o Do all numbers on game sheet need to be recorded?
- Zachary Meisnhiemer recommends putting all numbers on game sheet prior to game. If numbers change during game then adjust on game sheet after game before submitting.
- Steve FC Brookswood comment on game sheets
  - Is it possible to managers to submit numbers to league and then league provides game sheets to the teams?
  - Discussion of how to improve game sheets and referees feedback on the game
  - o Proposal to grant access to referees on the game sheets online
  - Zachary Meisnhiemer to discuss with head referee in the off season, proposals will be made to head referee
- Greg from Cariboo Hill A
  - Burnaby rink league every player has to have numbered chip prior to the start of each game
  - o Each player has to sign in with number
  - o Zachary Meisnhiemer would like to look at new systems for verifying players (FVSL, Burnaby rink systems to be examined)
- Andy
  - o Is there a reason why only 3 witness players are allowed on each team?
    - Zachary Meisnhiemer last year a proposal for 4 was raised but defeated
    - With 3 witness players there are already roster issues and ineligible players being played on current rosters.
    - 3 teams this year with issues on ineligible players
    - Due to injury witness players can be replaced with other witness players, with the provision that the original player does not return your roster
  - Can a witness player be moved to regular church attendee during the season?
    - Zachary Meisnhiemer it has to be done on the following season if that player continues to attend church regularly
- Vince from Grace Point
  - Started as a witness player and became Christian through the soccer ministry.
  - o This is the reason the league is around.

#### New Business

- Positions on board need to be filled next year
  - Secretary
  - o Statistician
  - Head field coordinator (organize all district negotiators)
  - Vice president
- Field coordinating needs help for next year
  - o 7 people involved this year but more people required for next year

- o Locations and times are not ideal this year
- Each district requires a local representative to have face to face meetings
- Possible Whitecaps Faith night for next season game
  - o Zachary Meisnhiemer to send information to all managers
