Home fields are as close as we can get to the churches, some are closer than others but this is limited by availability by each municipality.

Rosters

Derek McGowan reviewed guidelines for rosters and completing game sheets.

All players without photo to be deleted from website/system.

All rosters to be done through bccsl.com. Roster to be signed off by pastor and then emailed to rosters@bccsl.org

If a player has not been approved there is further information needed. This will need to be added immediately.

Every player has to have a correct and current email address for every active player on your roster.

****All rosters to be submitted by March 24th****

Do not add players until the first game has been played. No player will be added until after the roster freeze has been lifted.

****Rosters are frozen for until April 17th***

No players to be written on gamesheet under any circumstance. Only eligible and approved players by the registrar are allowed to enter the field of play.

Roster limit is 30 players. 4 witness/import players per roster.

****Roster/witness players can be replaced during the season. The replaced player is deactivated for the duration of the season.**

Research mobile cards being on phone. This would replace the id cards. Executive to look at as this would eliminate cards and save a lot of time with managing cards.

Game Management

Home team is responsible for providing a proper official game ball.

Corner flags are mandatory (from both teams)

Ref fees increased to \$70 – Make sure to have correct cash to pay the ref at the start of the game (Home team responsibility)

Order cards to match order of roster to speed up ref check in.

Red cards – responsibility of both managers to report on the red card to the league executive. Also the offending player must email the league as well.

- Add players number to your roster to save time during ref check
- Put cards in order of roster to also save time

Yellow cards – requires a 10 minute sit off period. If a ref does not know the rule it is your responsibility to alert the referee of this.

Game reporting:

- Done on bccsl.org
- Winning team reports (home team reports in the event of a tie)
- No spectators or fans allowed on the pitch. They can view from the stands or the opposite side of the fence.

Useful apps for team management are:

- Teamsnap
- Teamstuff

- Rosterbot

League Alignment

Insurance

This year insurance is requiring that each player has a waiver signed.

Every manager will be required to have each player sign a waiver acknowledging knowledge of insurance and the risk they are accepting by playing the game.

No player to enter the field of play until the waiver is signed.

Referees

Referee fees are \$70 this season. (Home team responsibility)

Please make sure you pay the referee BEFORE the game.

Please make sure referee signs your game sheet after the game.

If the ref does not show up to a game, it is the responsibility of each team to be responsible for a referee for half.
