



British Columbia Christian Soccer Criminal Record Check and Vulnerable Sector Check Requirement For Volunteer Coaches and Managers

To Whom It May Concern:

This letter confirms that the individual presenting it is volunteering with the BC Christian Soccer League, which operates annually.

In accordance with the BC Christian Soccer League Bylaws and Regulations, all volunteer coaches and team managers are required to complete and submit a Criminal Record Check, including a Vulnerable Sector Check, when serving in any capacity that involves interaction with participants under the age of 19.

The League permits players aged 15 years and older to participate. Where a team roster includes any participant under 19 years of age, each team's manager and coach is required to complete the prescribed background screening prior to participation.

The League's insurance provider requires the BC Christian Soccer League to maintain and enforce a formal Child Abuse Prevention and Protection Policy. The League takes its duty of care and the safety and well-being of all participants seriously. In addition to League requirements, each team is expected to operate in accordance with its affiliated church's child protection policies and procedures.
